GENERAL RULES FOR NDGSA PINEHURST 2025

- 1. The Mixed Pinehurst event will be 18 holes Stroke with teams comprising of mixed pairs or pairs of men/ladies. Hosted by the **Wirrabara Golf Club**, commencing with a **shotgun start** no later than 10.30am.
- 2. The host club will run the event and receive all entries. All entrants will become honorary members of the club for the weekend.
- 3. The Northern District Golf SA Inc. will be responsible for all trophies and advertising, although the host golf club may advertise and promote offers of meal and social specials available to participants. The host club is to provide any novelty prizes (Long Drives, NTP's) that they wish to run on the day
- 4. The entry fee will be \$40 per couple, payable to the Wirrabara Golf Club. Of that fee, \$5 per couple will be returned to the NDGSA Inc. and the balance retained by the hosting club.
- 5. The Wirrabara Golf Club will provide sausage sizzle lunch during the round and afternoon tea afterwards.
- 6. The host club can choose to run a raffle(s) on the day. Profits of the raffle will be retained by the host club.
- 7. The total number of teams will be limited to 34. Should nominations exceed 34 teams a ballot will be conducted to obtain the maximum number of 34.
- 8. Nominations will close five days prior to the event, ie the Tuesday of the week prior to the event so that if a ballot is required, clubs with multiple entries and affected by the ballot can decide which team is to be deleted.
- 9. Each club which enters on or before the closing date, shall have at least one team.
- 10. The district will contact the host club on the day following the closing date to ascertain if a ballot is required. If so, the District Men's Match Executive will conduct the ballot and inform the affected clubs.
- 11. A club may enter as many teams as it wishes, subject to a ballot if there are excessive entries.
- 12. All players must be current members of a club *affiliated and financial* with the Northern District Golf SA Inc.
- 13. Maximum handicap for NDGSA Inc. events is 36 for Men and 45 for Ladies. The handicaps provided in the nomination process are to be used on the day unless requested to update by a player or club.
- 14. Composite teams meeting the requirements of condition 12 may enter.
- 15. The use of motorised transport can be used without a medical certificate for this event.
- 16. Disputes, or otherwise, on the day of the event will be considered by the District Men's Match Executive, combined with the Match Committee of the host club. One trophy limit per team. Trophy precedence will be Championship winner, Championship runner-up, then Handicap winner and Handicap runner-up.
- 17. Any team having not paid the required entry fee prior to hit off will not be permitted to participate.
